Our organisation serves as a sanctuary for those with severe and profound disabilities, providing them with residential facilities, 24 hour medical care, a supportive community, and opportunities to lead fulfilling lives despite the challenges they face. Our residents come from diverse backgrounds, and we strive to create an inclusive environment that fosters personal growth, independence, and a sense of belonging.

- Paul Jungnickel Home and Paul Jungnickel Home Senior for severe and profound disabled adults are our main entity. Under the umbrella we provide a Protective Workshop and Vocational Workshop that caters for the homes residents and day visitors.
- Kungwini Early Childhood Development Centre provides early learning to children ranging in age from 6 months to 6 years of age that would otherwise not be able to attend school.
- Unjani Clinic provides easily accessible and affordable medical services to the community of Pretoria East, 6 days a week.

Our Need

Currently, we are facing a shortage of hospital beds, making it challenging to accommodate all bedridden residents in our facility. This shortage adversely affects their comfort, health, and overall well-being. With the growing number of individuals seeking our assistance, the need for additional beds has become imperative.

Budget Overview:

The estimated cost for the purchase of 25 hospital beds, including delivery, is **R 300 000.00**, working out to R12 000.00 per hospital bed. This amount covers high-quality, durable beds that meet the specific needs of our residents. We believe that this investment will significantly impact the lives of those we serve, providing them with a more comfortable and conducive living environment.


